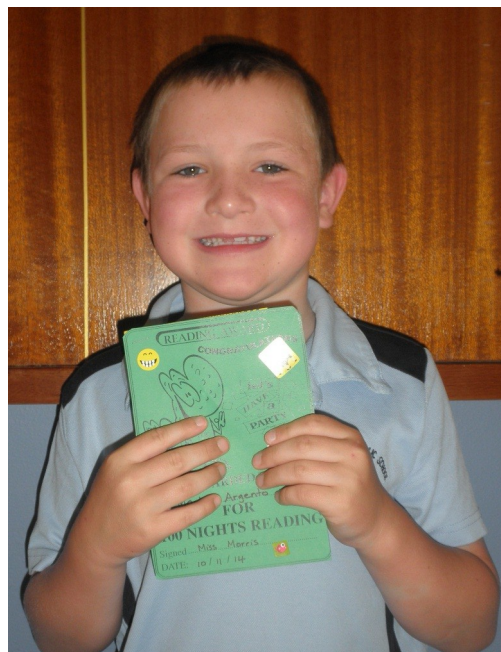
Student leaders will be announced at the Presentation Night on Wednesday 10 December.

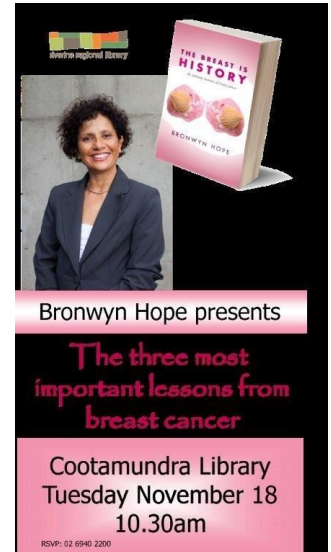
Remembrance Day
