The display boards were given a

new lease of life after being covered in red fabric.

There are many new books available for students to loan, which have recently been

covered. The kindles that were donated to the school by the Harden Touch Football Association, have had e-books downloaded and are available for senior students to use.

All students participate in a one hour library session on Wednesdays, with the exception of 3/4L who visit the library on Tuesday. Please encourage your children to bring a library bag and make the most of what our school library has to offer.

Sweet and Sour Walkathon Tissues Needed

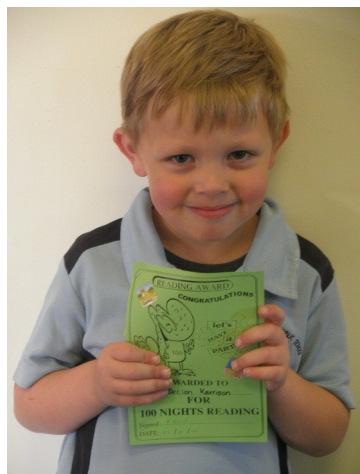
