

# TOWN

Taking Off with Numeracy for 3G and 4L classes is a great hit with the students. 10 minutes is spent daily, supported with extra teachers and an SLSO, for students to practise and develop mental strategies to add and subtract 2, 3 and 4

digits and develop a deep understanding of place value of four and five digit numbers.

The students are enthusiastically engaged in the practical activities that challenge their thinking. Initially, students rolled dice with 2 to 4 digit numbers and stated the number before and after as well as 10 before and after. When a student achieved this learning intention, students were then challenged to record numbers 100, 1000 and 50 before and after the number rolled. On the other hand, some students may require visual prompts and other devices to support their learning. The support in this activity was the use of a personal number chart.


Learning intentions for these sessions are based on the mathematics syllabus and the NSW

Numeracy Continuum. Plotting these markers of progression on the Numeracy Continuum strongly supports the practice at MPS whereby students are engaged at the point of new learning.

The collaborative culture in TOWN supplements the Prime Maths books that all students in Year 1 to 6 are involved in to provide a consistent approach to Mathematics across the primary years.
