Holiday on-line safety message...

Online bullying is different from other forms of bullying as it is more likely to happen outside school, harmful material can be shared quickly and long after the first incident, and it is more difficult school? We often have families who very much for children to defend themselves or get away. How to keep safe...

- Find out the age restrictions for the sites and applications your child wants to use.
- Depending on the age of your child set up your own accounts and 'friend' your child. By doing this, you can understand how the site's privacy settings work, see what your child posts online and how your child responds to posts made by others.
- Make sure that your child's account settings are set to 'private' to control who sees their information.
- Know how to block unwanted users.
- Remind your child to think carefully before they post comments, or upload or send Clare Crawford images online.
- Remind your child to tell a trusted adult if they are bullied online.

Always remember your audience may be bigger than you think...people will share your posts and

photos with others. They no longer belong to you. Going viral can happen to anyone! For more useful information...
