Tell Them From Me: Partners in learning survey



I am delighted that this term, our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: *Tell Them From Me* student, teacher and parent feedback survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

The survey is a great opportunity for our school community to provide us with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. Schools in Australia and around the world have used the *Tell Them From Me* survey to help improve how they do things. I want to assure you that the survey is confidential. The survey is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete.

Student surveys will be administered during school hours between 11 September and 13 October for students in years 4, 5, and 6. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary and consent forms have already

been sent home with these students. If you do not want your child or children to participate, please return the form to school by **Monday 4 September 2017.**

A day in the life of Year 2...

The students in Year 2 have been focusing on books about animals in preparation for our excursion to the zoo. They have been learning about fact and opinion, and the students have used this knowledge to complete a number of narratives and informative writing tasks. One of the tasks was to read the book "Dear Zoo" and select one zoo animal that they would like as a pet. Students planned their writing by drawing a picture of their chosen animal and explained why they wanted the animal.

Students then participated in a modelled writing lesson before they started their own letter to the zoo, where they were asked to introduce themselves, explain why they would like to have that animal as a pet and how they would take care of it.

During mathematics the students have been learning about completing addition number sentences. The focus this week was solving number sentences that equal 100. This required students to use their knowledge of friends of ten and use various problem solving strategies. The students enjoyed using the MAB blocks and number charts to assist with solving these number sentences.
