Can I say firstly, how grateful I am that all students and staff have returned from the break safe and well. Let's count our blessings! Everyone is refreshed and ready to take-on term two. We have a quality team of teachers, school learning support officers and administration staff who are keen to see every child reach their potential.

Encouraging regular school attendance is one of the most powerful ways you can help your child to reach their potential—both in school and in life. When you make school attendance a priority, you help your child feel more connected to their community, develop important social skills and friendships, and are significantly more likely to graduate from high school, setting them up for a strong future.

Obviously if children are not well, they need to be cared for at home, however when students attend school on a regular basis (over 90%), their outcomes improve. However when students are absent for an average of just two days of school per month—even when the absences are excused—it can have a negative impact. These absences can affect kids as early as Kindergarten.

Thank you to all the families who attended the ANZAC ceremony during the holidays. It was great that over 60 students were in attendance. Our school ceremony held last Friday was a moving occasion with students clearly demonstrating their respect for the sacrifice made be service men and women.

I am so proud to include in this newsletter photos of our students engaged in their learning this morning. Every student in every classroom was happily on-task. Classroom teachers, support teachers and school learning support officers were all working with individual groups of students with learning tasks tailored to fit students needs. Our beautiful, big, flexible learning spaces are being utilised so well.
