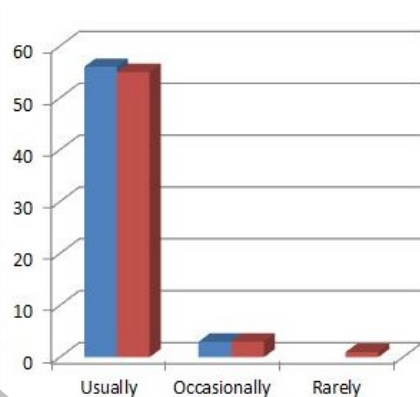

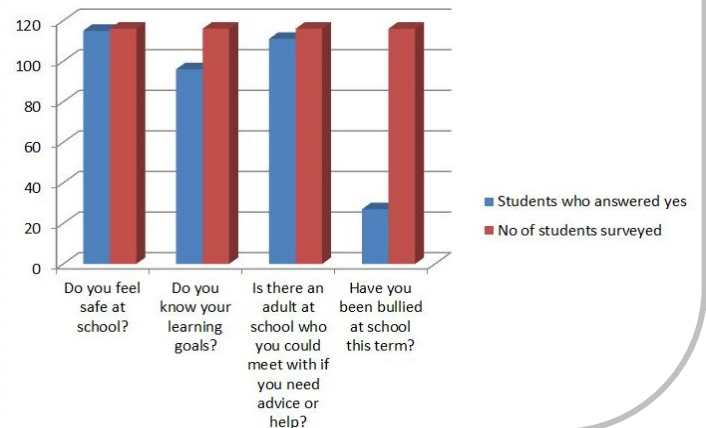

It is a pleasure to share with you the fantastic results from our recent paper based survey. Thank you to all the families who returned the survey to the front office. Over 50% of families returned the survey which gives us useful information for planning for the future. Overwhelmingly people felt very positive about the school, the opportunities offered and appreciative of the teachers and staff.

Your comments have given some directions for improvement, particularly in relation to communication. The school executive team and the teachers will be proactive in their response to your suggestions.

The graph on the bottom right hand corner represents data collected from year 1 to year 6 students at school last week using the CUPS survey.

This data will also be used as evidence of the school's performance in our upcoming External Validation on Tuesday 11 September. As mentioned in a previous newsletter this term, an External Validation is a process where evidence is presented to a panel that validate the evidence presented, using the School Excellence Framework as a guide.

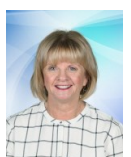
As promised, students who handed their survey in went into the draw to win a \$5 canteen voucher.
