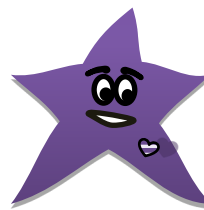
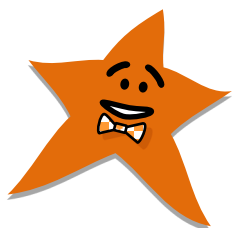

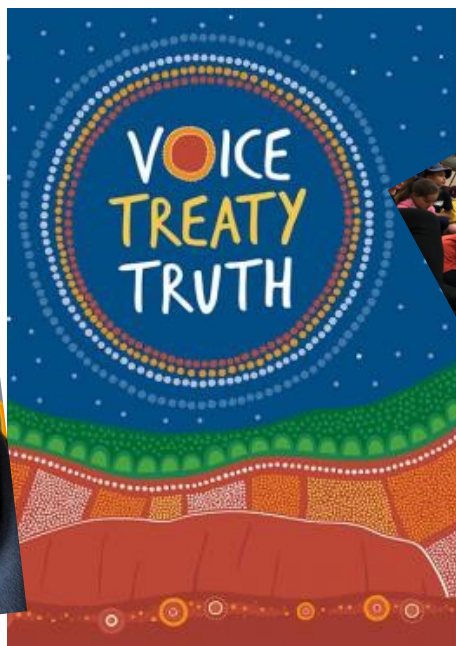


Never give up - understand the Power of Yet
