New enrolment policy

The new enrolment policy for students across NSW government schools, contains some important changes that parents and carers need to know. Each school will have a local intake area and a cap on students numbers set by the government from term 4 2019.

If your child is already enrolled in a school outside of the catchment area, they will remain enrolled at that school. There will be no changes to enrolment rights of siblings of non-local students. We will continue to provide families with support and advice during the enrolment process, including exceptional and compelling circumstances.
