A day in the life of 10

1D is a very happy and busy class. The students have formed close friendships and it's lovely to see them interact. During our morning session students are reading and changing their home readers, looking at the calendar and enjoying our fruit break. Mr Shean our SLSO is a great support to the students in 1D.

Every week, we have a focus book which I read to the whole class and each day we revisit the story to examine different literacy strategies.

Students then move to working in literacy groups. The main focus of which is reading comprehension, phonics and spelling. After literacy groups we move to writing with sentence construction and writing recounts as the focus this semester.

Technology also plays a big part of our daily learning with Reading Eggs and other literacy sites being popular. This year children have shown their skill at logging into the computer.

After lunch, we enjoy a Smiling Minds session.

During maths rotation students participate in 'Count Me In Too' and other number games as a part of their rotations. Students enjoy the counting games we do as a whole class using songs or our little white boards.

Our afternoon sessions include history, PD Health and social play. On Thursdays we are fortunate to enjoy PE with Mr Shean who always engages the children with interesting activities.
