This was a great opportunity for our teachers to spend time with students that they don't get to see on a regular basis and a great transition opportunity for our year 2 students!


To wrap up a great day, we ended the morning with a sausage sizzle for all our students and staff.

Ingredients

2 Apples grated and peeled

1 ½ cups SR flour

2 eggs

2 tbsp baking powder
